OUR HISTORIC SITES

A uniquely American story

People wonder...why so many separate entities for such a small town? Well...they each tell a piece of the tale...



Highlights the town's formation around the Mississippi and how that relationship influenced everything from agriculture to commerce told by exploring four historic properties and the lives of its inhabitants.



State Historic Site

Relive early mercantile life from the State-run Felix Valle house, where the home of one of our earliest merchants features a reproduction shop of local trade goods.



Centre for French Colonial Life

Gives insight into the French settlers transformation into Americans through a tidy museum and tours of the Bolduc and Lemellier homes.



Foundation for Restoration

Features the best example of a Normand Truss in the US and is run by ancestors of the town's forebears who work to keep their French heritage alive.



Museum Learning Center

Tells the beginning of our story (dinosaurs/mineral formation) and the industrialized 19th and 20th century through an immense archaeological collection and riveting displays.



Art Guild

Learn of Ste. Gen's art colony founded by women painters, Aimee Schweig and Jesse Beard Rickley, brought to prominence by the likes of Thomas Hart Benton and Joe Jones.

FESTIVALS

Ste. Genevieve is home to some particularly sweet festivals for people looking for a slower pace of life. We value our history, and in doing so we help preserve and share those traditional d.i.y. activities that are regaining popularity today.







